CONTENTS OF THE COURSE

The way of learning is innovative, with a lot of project work, e-learning, visiting international professors, guest speakers, company visits, etc.

The first year contains general business subjects and is identical for all International Studies students.



INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RESOURCES (BOL)

After the first year you can choose where to put the emphasis for your future. The International Human Resources education is one of three varieties within International Studies and has its focus on Human Resources - i.e. Recruitment & Selection, Career Planning, etc. - as well the commercial business subjects.

SUBJECTS ARE

- Business subjects, such as Management; Marketing; Human Resources; Economics; Logistics; etc.
- International subjects: Foreign Languages (e.g. English, German, French, Spanish); Cultural Differences; etc.
- Relationships Subjects: Communication Skills; Thinking Skills; Discussion Techniques; Personal Development; etc.

DIPLOMAS

- Dutch diploma level 4 "Ondernemer Groothandel" (crebo 10002)
- English diploma: Edexcel "BTEC National in Business, Human Resources",
- Optional: Diploma "BEC Business English Cambridge"

This study is part of the International Studies Department which provides three varieties of International Studies at the Koning Willem I College.

DURATION

A 3 years, full-time course.

SCHEDULE

Daily from 9.00 - 16.00 hrs with extension possibilities from 8.30 until 17.00 hrs.

DESCRIPTION

"BTEC Nationals in Business, Human Resources" and "Ondernemer Groothandel" have been developed to:

- Educate and train students to be employed in a variety of business activities - such as accounting administration, finance, human resource management, IT, marketing management - with a specialization in Human Resources.
- Teach to understand the relationships within the team/department in which they work, and learn to choose the right person for the right job, organizing the right education for this.
- Train to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance in working life.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to this course, you have to meet one of the following requirements:

- Vmbo-diploma (preparatory secondary education): vocationally oriented route, mixed educational route, theoretical route Economics
- Vmbo-diploma: vocationally oriented route, mixed educational route, theoretical route Technology/Health and Personal Care and Welfare/Agriculture with Mathematics or Economics or second Foreign Language
- Promotion qualification to havo/vwo 4 (senior general education/pre-university education) or equivalent education

NEXT STEPS

- a study at Higher Vocational Education (hbo colleges) in the Netherlands
- start a study anywhere in the world based on the BTEC National Diploma in Business, Human Resources.
